

ALIGNED LITERACY INTERVENTIONS

Participants will explore literacy assessments, learning difficulties, and evidence-aligned methods for supporting academically, culturally and linguistically diverse students. From dispelling misconceptions about Dyslexia, Dysgraphia, and Developmental Language Disorder to designing lessons to help all students succeed, such as universal design principles and the taxonomy of intervention intensity. Educators will explore explicit strategies to improve literacy for all learners. Participants will learn to interpret literacy assessments to target instruction and be able to provide supports for multilingual and bidialectal learners while harnessing their strengths. Finally, participants will engage in practice opportunities to integrate evidence-aligned supports into their current literacy block.
