- Analyze MAP reports to identify readiness levels, entry points, and learning priorities.
- Apply MAP insights to plan differentiated Tier 1 instruction and targeted Tier 2 supports.
- Monitor student progress using MAP data and adjust instruction responsively over time.
- Design a plan for sustained classroom-level MTSS data routines that support ongoing instructional improvement.

- Use MAP data to monitor progress and inform short-term instructional responses.
- Reflect on how MAP data can strengthen existing classroom MTSS routines and decision-making practices.
